- 4. Cut out all of the kaleidoscopes and apply glitter glue on the points (or around the outer edges) of all of the stars. When the glitter glue has dried, create two piles with one of each size kaleidoscope in each pile. (**Figure 4**)
- 5. Using removable adhesive, adhere one of the largest (3.5") kaleidoscopes to the piece of coordinating card stock. Using the kaleidoscope as a guide, cut the cardstock slightly larger than the kaleidoscope. (Figure 5) Remove the kaleidoscope from the cardstock and return it to its respective pile, *taking care not to adhere it to any of the other kaleidoscopes*. If desired, apply glitter glue around the outside edge of the cardstock star and wait for it to dry. Then turn over and apply glitter glue to the outside edge of the other side.
- 6. Use a strong tape to adhere the metallic cording to the cardstock base in a loop for hanging the ornament. (**Figure 6**)
- 7. For each pile, mount the kaleidoscopes on top of each other using the adhesive foam squares. Start with the 3.5" kaleidoscope on the bottom and put the next smallest (3") on top, centering each kaleidoscope on the one beneath it. End with the 1.5" kaleidoscope on top. (**Figure 7**)

8. Mount the two kaleidoscope stacks on either side of the cardstock with permanent adhesive. (**Figure 8**)
